High and low risk. Where to look things up. Write and document in green notes. Screening AN. Give antiemetics more often to pregnant women. What to refer. AFLP. PEP. Thromboprophylaxis. To refer pt with 2 x UTI. Management of lower FM. Common causes of common problems, - reassurance. Prepregnancy counselling. AFLP.
